

Deadly weekend on city's east side

BUFFALO, NY (WIVB) - Buffalo police are still looking for suspects after a violent weekend on the city's east side left one person dead and five injured.

It started Friday night around nine when detectives say 17-year old Edward Battles was shot while driving on Minnesota Avenue.

He remains in critical condition at ECMC.

A 14-year old girl standing in a nearby driveway was hit in the leg. She's expected to be okay.

Just minutes later, police rushed to Fillmore Avenue where they say several shooters opened fire on two teens.

17-year old David Hyshaw was pronounced dead at ECMC.

Dewey Taylor, also 17, was treated and released for a gunshot wound to his leg.

And shots rang out just a few blocks up Fillmore Avenue later that night, injuring two more people.

Those injuries aren't believed to be life threatening.

Local activists rallied outside city hall over the weekend, demanding an end to the violence.

"We want to get out of our four walls within the walls of our congregation, we want to get out within the community are, where are children are, where are grieving mothers and grandmothers are. We're tired of going to funerals. We want to go to celebrations. We want to go to graduations," said local activist **Ava White** of "Voice Buffalo".

The group held the rally and is made up of church members from across the city.
